

Priming the Purifier:

The Purifier will need to be primed before use and after each prolonged storage. This should be done BEFORE you start your outing and with water that is from a known safe source such as your kitchen sink.

1. Slip a hose clamp over the end of the faucet adapter tube.
2. Insert the end of Purifier into the faucet adapter tube. (Warming the end of the faucet adapter tube in hot water will make it easier to slide the tube on.) Make sure the Flow Direction Arrow is pointing away from the faucet adapter.
3. Tighten the hose clamp with a screw driver.
4. Push the faucet adapter onto your faucet (some force may be required, hold the faucet securely while pushing on the faucet adapter).
5. Set the Purifier into sink pointing away from you.



6. While holding the faucet adapter in place on the faucet (if you do not hold the faucet adapter on the faucet, it will pop back off when the pressure increases), **SLOWLY** turn on the faucet just a little bit. Wait for the pressure to build and the air to be pushed out, this needs to be done slowly and will take about a minute. The flow through the filter will start off very slowly and then increase. If the faucet adapter keeps popping off before you get flow through the filter, you will need to move to another faucet with a tighter fit.
7. While still holding the faucet adapter on the faucet, **SLOWLY** open the faucet more as the flow increases and let the water run for a few minutes.
8. Turn off faucet and remove faucet adapter.
9. Remove hose clamp from Purifier.
10. Remove faucet adapter tube from Purifier.
